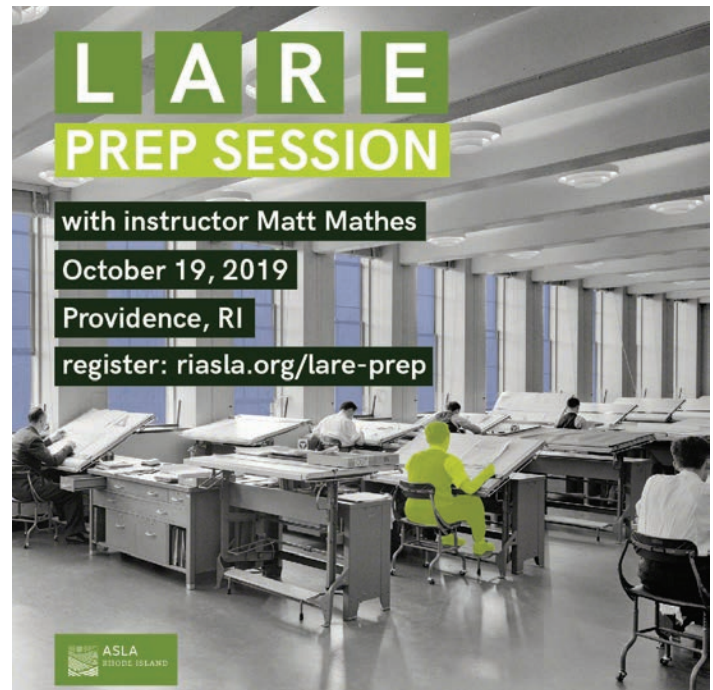

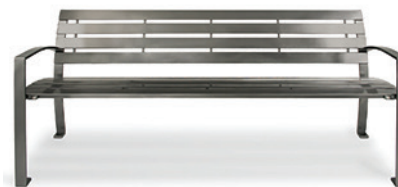

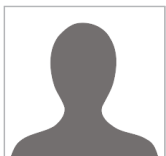
OPEN POSITION! **Membership Chair**

Additionally, they will grow the chapter by participating in quarterly Membership Chair conference call, which will be used as a forum to share ideas and successes in increasing chapter membership.

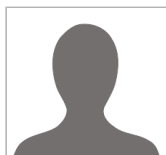


OPEN POSITION! **Sponsorship Chair**

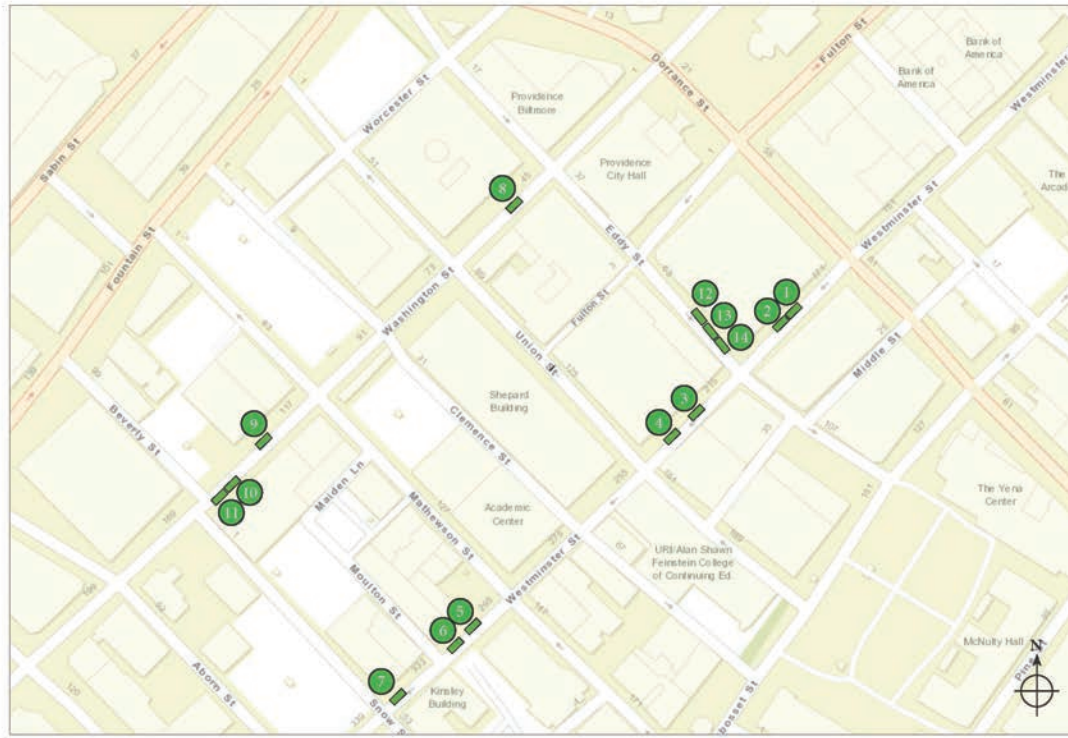

Parklet designers work with local businesses, bringing enthusiasm and energy to the area, while being sensitive to the needs of the shopkeepers and their customers.

PARK(ing) Day celebrates and strengthens our connection with nature, our sense of community, and enhances the overall public awareness about the importance of green space in our urban environment.
